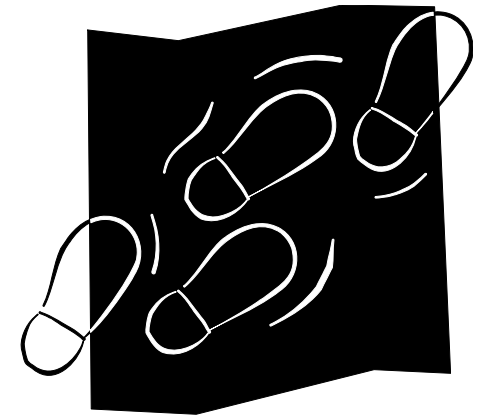

Drug Free Workplace Training

The agency is certified to provide Bureau of Worker's Compensation Drug Free Workplace Training for employees and supervisors. If needed we can also help with Drug Free Workplace policies and procedures. Drug screening available upon request.

Assessment

Assessments help determine the nature of the problem and/or the involvement with mood-altering substances and its effect on the lives of the individuals and family members.

Individual Counseling

Counselors work with adults and youth to help them identify problems and develop strategies to help them resolve issues that cause or contribute to the strain and disruption of their lives.

Group Counseling

Adult or youth groups meet with a counselor as group members help each other identify and resolve the problems they are experiencing.

Intensive Outpatient Program

A treatment group which meets 3 hours, 3 times a week and provides intensive treatment while allowing the individual to continue with everyday responsibilities such as work and family.

Prevention Education

Presentations and groups are available to individuals, schools, and community groups.

Putnam Adolescent Response Team for Youth (P.A.R.T.Y.)

Available for all high school youth

The goal of our agency is to provide services for Putnam County residents and surrounding areas who are experiencing difficulties in day to day living. We provide referral and information, assessment, treatment, education, consultation, support and guidance depending on the nature of the problem and its severity. Services are available to children, adolescents, and adults within individual, group, or family settings.

Our professional staff members are experienced and knowledgeable in their respective disciplines and are credentialed as required by the State of Ohio.

Psychiatric Services

Psychiatric evaluations are provided by the physician. Medication education and monitoring are provided as needed.

Community Support Services

Support services are available to assist clients with linkages to necessary services to facilitate treatment.

Mental Health Education

The staff offers programs such as parenting classes, educational presentations and support groups. These programs are available to individuals and organizations.

Housing Services

Group homes, independent living apartments, community support services, supervised support services, and a housing assistance program assist clients in gaining independence.

Adult/Adolescent Anger Management Group

These sessions are designed to deal with the impact of anger management on the individual, family and society.
